

## Index

References to passages of special interest or importance are sometimes placed in italics, and occasionally then by themselves at the beginning of an entry. Greek words are transliterated. As a rule, I have not mentioned separately here those passages in the Notes which can easily be found by consulting the relevant part of the main text (or appendices) where references are given to the notes concerned.

I had intended to provide an Index of Sources, but the task proved an impossible one, owing to the vast number and range of the sources cited above. I have tried to make up for this to some extent by giving in this Index, under the names of the authors concerned, references to passages in which I have written (or mentioned) a discussion of some texts of special interest; and the same applies to some modern works that are either important or at least well known.
